Awaiting 1 group planning to become Inactive – last meeting May 12
Awaiting 11 Active groups in the process of annual updates
Total of 15 Ohio will be Active Alateen meetings (1 will be Inactive)

ASBR status:

We have been using the new ASBR with new AMIAS forms, that was accepted at the Fall 2024 Assembly. We also received approval from the WSO on December 12, 2024. WSO recommended 3 minor housekeeping edits, one that requires information from attorney and review by ASBR Task force. Once those are resolved we will update the ASBR and Handbook.

While using the new AMIAS forms, one typo was discovered in Form 3, the new FBI fingerprinting reason code is missing a “C” in the “/VA”, it will be updated to “NCPA/VCA” in our next updates to ASBR and Handbook.

Using the new ASBR AMIAS forms and the optional Electronic Signature forms has been a tremendous benefit to the 2025 Recertification process.

- It resolved some issues with the old form that delayed processing
- Helped clarify if a phone number was a cell or home number in online records
- Electronic Signature forms gave an option to AMIAS – 7 people chose it
 - One electronic signature form needed to be downloaded and completed on paper
