

DISTRICT 10 REPORT

Over the last several months, as District Representative of District 10, I have been working to keep the groups in District 10 connected to each other and Districts of Toledo.

One of the ways I do this is by sending a reminder a few days before the Districts meeting to invite Group Representatives to the meeting. I also provide a copy of the minutes from the previous meeting and the agenda, if it is available.

Some new faces from District 10 have shown up at the Districts meeting. It's gratifying to see new members taking an interest in Districts by volunteering to be a GR or representing their group ad hoc.

Our three Districts of Toledo Representatives have also been communicating with each other and Ann F. and Rose R. I have appreciated Ann and Rose's guidance and advice as we make decisions about actions we can take to improve information sharing and accommodating our members' attendance at meetings.

We agreed to reduce the number of District meetings from 8 meetings per year to 7. Five of the 7 meetings will be on Zoom and 2 will be face to face. In 2025, Districts will meet in February, March and April on Zoom. In May, we will hold a face to face meeting (including food and fellowship before the meeting). No meetings will be held June through August. Meetings will resume in September. September and November will be Zoom meetings. October will be a face to face meeting (with food and fun). DOT will not meet in December and January.

We are also in the process of posting the recently updated DOT Guidelines to the Toledo Al-Anon website.

Other activities I have engaged in have been to distribute the Conflict Resolution pamphlet to District 10 groups, sign recertification forms for AMAIS volunteers and refer a new GR to the WSO Group Record Change Form to update the group's records.
